RESOLVE, in Favor of Hamlin Plantation.

Hamlin plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of Hamlin plantation by the 93rd legislature for the repairing of the Daigle road, so called, being a continuation of work done under previous special resolve be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended during the fiscal years ending June 30, 1950 and June 30, 1951, as follows:

\$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and \$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to aid in repairing the Remi Cyr road, so called, beginning where repairing ended under previous special resolve and continuing in a southerly direction toward the intersection of the Roy road, so called.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is badly in need of repair and the appropriation made by the 93rd legislature was supposed to have been for the Remi Cyr road and through error was designated to be used on the Daigle road.
