### AN ACT Relating to Road Equipment on Private Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 31-A, additional. Chapter 84 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 31-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 31-A. Use of highway equipment on private ways. The inhabitants of any town at a legal town meeting may authorize the selectmen of said town to use its highway equipment on private ways within such town whenever such selectmen deem it advisable in the best interests of the town, and for fire and police protection.'
