STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing Contests on Inland Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 44-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 44-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 44-A. Fishing contests on inland waters. It shall be unlawful for any person or group of persons to conduct a fishing contest wherein entry fees are accepted as prizes offered. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a contest wherein all the contestants are 16 years of age or under or to a contest conducted by the state of Maine, such as the "The One That Did Not Get Away Club"; and provided further that the provisions of this section shall not apply to the counties of Cumberland, Kennebec and York.'
