**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge to Release Certain
Rights to Eunice Winslow of Rockland.**

Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District authorized to release certain rights.
Resolved: That the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District be, and hereby is, authorized to release to Eunice Winslow of Rockland all of its rights and interest in a certain parcel of land located in Little Deer Isle and taken by the bridge district from Jeremiah W. Eaton by eminent domain procedure and recorded on October 20, 1936, which land was part of the lands taken by the bridge district for an approach to the Deer Isle-Sedgwick bridge and which was later abandoned in favor of another location.
