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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold E. Rogers of Brunswick.**

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**Harold E. Rogers; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$771.20 to be paid to Harold E. Rogers of Brunswick, to reimburse him for hospital and medical expenses paid by him for his son, Norman Rogers, who became ill while in the National Guard; such appropriation to be paid from the funds of the adjutant general's department.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Norman Rogers was inoculated while in the National Guard in April 1948. He became very ill and is now in the Augusta State Hospital. This resolve is to reimburse his father for expenses incurred because of such illness.
