RESOLVE, in Favor of Herman I. Ham of Madison.

Herman I. Ham; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$74 to be paid to Herman I. Ham, of Madison, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for 37 fowl killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

,

Foxes killed 37 six months old pullets, weighing approximately 5 pounds each. The foxes were seen carrying the fowl away. The case was investigated by Walter Rowell.
