RESOLVE, in Favor of Madelyn Ames, of East Poland.

Madelyn Ames; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$73.20 to be paid to Madelyn Ames, of East Poland, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for rabbits killed by dogs; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A pen of 75 rabbits, owned by Madelyn Ames, was broken into by dogs. Investigation by Selectman Glen W. Torrey disclosed the fact that 56 were counted dead and 6 were missing. At that time the market price was 20c per pound.
