STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Prentiss Plantation.

Prentiss Plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$484.80 be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Prentiss Plantation to reimburse the said plantation for money due it since 1938 under the provisions of section 201 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, said sum to be paid from the appropriation of the department of education.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Although the White school, so called, was closed, the school was never reported to the department of education as a closed school. Therefore the plantation incurred yearly expenses for conveyance of the pupils who would have attended the White school as listed:
