RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Dedham.

Town of Dedham; interest charged off. Resolved: That the treasurer of state be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sum of \$347.55, interest on state taxes, now charged against the town of Dedham for the years 1944 to 1947, inclusive.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Dedham is in a very difficult financial condition due to an accumulation of large expenditures, chiefly large bills for forest fire fighting and snow removal; and auditing bills due to transactions with Lucerne-in-Maine Village Corporation.
