RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Princeton.

Town of Princeton; charging off of account. Resolved: That the treasurer of state and the state controller be, and hereby are, authorized to charge off the books of the state the sum of \$305.69 for stumpage taken from Indian Township, Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Stumpage on 30,569 spruce, pine and hemlock @ \$10 per M was taken from Indian township. As several Indian children attend the high school at Princeton, it is felt the stumpage should not be paid by the town.
