STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Relating to the Use of Purse, Drag or Stop Seines in

Use of purse, drag or stop seines in Damariscotta river. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to repeal that part of rule and regulation numbered 127, which prohibits any person from using any purse, drag or stop seine for all fish except alewives in Damariscotta river above a line drawn from Farnham's Head in the town of Boothbay to a point opposite on the shore in the town of Bristol, excepting the use of drag seines between the above line and The Ledges and to issue the following rule and regulation in place thereof:

'No person shall use any purse, drag or stop seines in Damariscotta river northerly of the bridge between the villages of Newcastle and Damariscotta for the purpose of taking fish of any kind; nor shall any person use any purse, drag or stop seines between the said bridge and The Ledges, for any fish except alewives.'
