RESOLVE, in Favor of Maynard Marsh of Gorham.

Commissioner authorized to pay for operation for Maynard Marsh. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized to pay for an operation to be performed on Maynard Marsh of Gorham because of injuries inflicted upon said Marsh while performing his duties as an inland fish and game warden, and be it further

Resolved: That such expenditure shall not exceed \$1,000 and shall be paid from funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Marsh, as an inland fish and game warden, was badly injured when run over by an automobile operated by poachers on September 17, 1946 and an operation upon one of Mr. Marsh's legs is essential.
