AN ACT Relating to the Use of Electrolysis in Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 208, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 208 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘The use of electrolysis for the removal of hair is not a part of the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture and is prohibited except under the direction of a licensed physician.’
