RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Donnell's Pond in the Town of Franklin in the County of Hancock.

Outlet of Donnell's Pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Donnell's pond in the town of Franklin, Hancock county, for the purpose of raising the height of the screen and dam; provided, however, that the town of Franklin shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and the keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only ½ the cost of said screen.
