STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of Register of Deeds and Clerk Hire in Offices of Register of Deeds and Register of Probate in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of probate of Lincoln county, as amended by section 6 of chapter 154 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1,200 \$1,820;'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the register of deeds in Lincoln county, as amended by section 5 of chapter 154 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, \$1,600 \$1,820,'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds of Lincoln county, as amended by chapter 339 of the public laws

of 1945 and by section 6 of chapter 154 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$1,200 \$1,400, and such additional sum not exceeding \$600, when necessary, subject to the approval of the county commissioners;'
