STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Beatrice Noonan, of Boston, Massachusetts.

World War bonus of Patrick J. Noonon granted to Beatrice Noonan.
Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated \$100 to be paid to
Beatrice Noonan, of Boston, Massachusetts, as the World War bonus of
her deceased husband, Patrick J. Noonan; said sum to be paid from the
general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Every honorably discharged veteran of World War I was voted a state bonus of \$100 if application was made by a certain date. Mr. Noonan did not make his application before the specified date and it is now requested that it be paid to his widow, Beatrice Noonan. Patrick Noonan, then of Milo, was inducted into the U. S. Army May 23, 1918 and was honorably discharged December 3, 1918.
