STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of a Bridge Across the St. John River in Allagash Plantation.

Bridge to be constructed over St. John river. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$150,000 to assist Allagash plantation in building a bridge across the St. John river in Allagash plantation, at or near the "present ferry site"; and be it further

Resolved: That any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished; and be it further

Resolved: That after the construction of such bridge, Allagash plantation shall pay to the state \$5,000 per year for 10 successive years; such money to be credited to the general highway fund.
