STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Providing for State Pension for Elmira A. Brown, of Lewiston.

Elmira A. Brown; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Elmira A. Brown, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Said pension shall begin on July 1, 1949, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of chapter 103 of the resolves of 1945 which provides for a state pension for Elmira A. Brown, of Lewiston, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Elmira A. Brown is 74 years of age, has arthritis and is unable to work. The pension which she is now receiving is not sufficient for her needs.
