IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of James A. Boyle, of Portland.

James A. Boyle; prior service credit. Resolved: That the city of Portland is hereby authorized and permitted to transfer to the state of Maine such credits in the state retirement system as said city has acquired both as membership service credits and prior service credits in said retirement system for the retirement benefit of James A. Boyle, of Portland, and upon said transfer and upon his depositing in the retirement fund such contributions as he had made thereto as an employee of said city; a participating local district, he shall be given 25 years prior credit service as an employee of the state of Maine in accordance with the provisions of section 4 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes and shall be entitled to the benefits of paragraph B of subsection II of section 6 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.
