RESOLVE, in Favor of O. E. Weymouth, of Lincoln.

O. E. Weymouth; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$357 to be paid to O. E. Weymouth, of Lincoln, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for 119 pullets killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Weymouth lost 119 pullets which were 4 or 5 months old, weight 5 pounds, between August 9 and August 20, 1948. This case was investigated by W. R. Benson and it is his opinion that foxes were responsible for the loss of said pullets and that the pullets were properly enclosed at the time.
