RESOLVE, in Favor of George V. Jordan, of North Waldoboro.

George V. Jordon; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$377.98 from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to George V. Jordon, of North Waldoboro, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 15, 1948, at Kennebunk, and was investigated by Game Warden Henry H. Gross. The radiator, grill and right front fender were badly damaged; the left front fender and hood were damaged, right front headlamp broken and possible other damage.
