RESOLVE, in Favor of Louise W. Cony, of Augusta.

Louise W. Cony; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$31 from the general relief fund of the department of health and welfare, to be paid to Louise W. Cony, of Augusta, as a full and final settlement of her claim against the state for damage done to her iron fence by a truck from Jefferson Camp.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A truck from Jefferson Camp was delivering wood to a neighbor of Mrs. Cony and backed into her iron fence, damaging the fence to the extent of \$31. This happened in May, 1946. A bill was not presented until some time later, then it was placed for payment April 13, 1948. This bill was held up by the controller's office, stating it should have been taken care of by the insurance company. The accident was not reported to the insurance company due to the fact that the driver of the truck did not know he had done any damage to the fence.
