STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, of Augusta.

New England Telephone and Telegraph Company; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$41.87 from the general fund of the state to be paid to New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, of Augusta, to reimburse said company for the cost of replacing a telephone pole.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A truck from Jefferson Camp during a sleet storm and while on the way to deliver a load of wood, went off the road on route No. 1, Gardiner road, Whitefield, and struck a telephone pole on or about January 28, 1946.

The driver of the truck, an inmate of Jefferson Camp, did not realize his responsibility to report the damage he had done, and the department of health and welfare was not notified until it was brought to the attention of the department by the telephone company. The cost of replacing the telephone pole was \$41.87.
