RESOLVE, in Favor of General Ice Cream Corporation, of Rockland.

General Ice Cream Corporation; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$130.68 from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to General Ice Cream Corporation, of Rockland, as a full and final settlement of its claim against the state for damage to its car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on September 3, 1948, at Lincolnville, and was investigated by Game Warden Roland C. Abbott. Damage was caused to the right headlight, right front fender, right side of radiator, grill, and the radiator pushed back against the fan causing radiator to leak badly, hood dented and pushed back toward the windshield.
