STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY

AN ACT Providing for the Reallocation of Part of the Betterment Appropriation in Favor of State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 208, § 1, amended. Sub-paragraph 6, of paragraph C. of section 1 of chapter 208 of the private and special laws of 1949 is hereby amended by adding at the end of said sub-paragraph 6 the following:

'Provided that of the above mentioned amount authorized for the fiscal year 1950-1951 ten percent shall be used for improvement of designated state aid highways.'
