SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 790, "Joint Order Relating to
Automobile Markers for Members and Officers."

Amend said Order by striking out all after the word
"concurring" in the first line thereof, and inserting in place
the following:

'that the Secretary of State provide to each member of the
Senate and House of the 95th Legislature, in addition to the
regular automobile registration plates issued to him, suitable
plates to be attached by such member to his automobile, and be
it further

ORDERED, that such plates shall designate membership in the
Maine Legislature and shall not be used after the first Wednesday
of January, 1953, and be it further

ORDERED, that the expenses incurred under the provisions of
this Order shall be apportioned among the members ordering such
plates not to exceed \$2.00 per member, and such money shall be
credited to the Motor Vehicle Appropriation of the Secretary of
State, and be it further

ORDERED, that the Secretary of State provide to the President
of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, the Secretary of the
Senate, and the Clerk of the House similar plates designating
their official positions.'
