STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Certified Seed.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 27, § 124, amended. Section 124 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 124. Certified seed, defined. The term "certified seed" as used in this chapter shall be deemed to mean potatoes potato, or such vegetable, forage crop or grain seeds as shall have been grown and prepared for sale in accordance with regulations laid down by the commissioner and for which a certificate or tag has been issued as provided in section 127. Authority to make all reasonable rules and regulations hereunder is given the said commissioner.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 27, § 125, amended. The 1st sentence of section 125 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows: 'Any grower of potatoes potato, or vegetable, forage crop or grain seeds may make application to the commissioner for inspection and certification of his crop growing or to be grown in this state, giving description of his land and such information as the said commissioner may require.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 27, § 126, repealed. Section 126 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
