**AN ACT Relating to Free Hunting and Fishing Licenses for Maine
Veterans on Leave.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ VIII-A, additional. Section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered VIII-A, to read as follows:

‘VIII-A. In time of war or national emergency, residents of Maine who are on leave or furlough from active duty in the armed forces of the United States shall, upon application to the clerk of the city or town of his residence, be issued a license to hunt or fish without payment of any fee.’
