STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Open Black Pond, in the County of Oxford.

Regulating fishing in Black pond in the county of Oxford. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Black pond in the town of Sweden in the county of Oxford to fishing from the time ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
