STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Disclosure Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 107, § 42, amended. The 1st sentence of section 42 of chapter 107 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The magistrate shall be entitled to 25c for each subpoena, 75e \$1 for entry, 25e 50c for capias, 25e 50c for certificate, and \$3 for each day in hearing the disclosure and other testimony, and for entering default, 25c.'
