SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 61, L. D. 27, Bill "An Act to  
Authorize the Building of a Road Across  
Massacre Pond, in Scarborough."

Amend said Bill by inserting in the Title before the word  
"Road" the word 'Private'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Gladys I. Jordan authorized to build private road.'

Gladys I. Jordan, of Scarborough, in the county of Cumberland and  
state of Maine, her heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and  
empowered to build and maintain a private road across Massacre  
pond, so called, a great pond, situated in Scarborough, in the county  
of Cumberland, said private road to extend from land owned by said  
Gladys I. Jordan on the northwesterly side of said Massacre pond to  
land owned by her in common with another on the southeasterly side  
of said Massacre pond; provided that a bridge be constructed in  
said road at least 8 feet in length and of sufficient height to  
permit the free passage of rowboats, canoes and their occupants  
under said bridge.'
