STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize the Building of a Road Across Massacre Pond, in Scarboro.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Gladys I. Jordan authorized to build road. Gladys I. Jordan, of Scarboro, in the county of Cumberland and state of Maine, her heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a road across Massacre pond, so called, a great pond, situated in Scarboro, in the county of Cumberland, said road to extend from land owned by said Gladys I. Jordan on the northwesterly side of said Massacre pond to land owned by her on the southeasterly side of said Massacre pond, said road to have adequate water flowage facilities through same.
