STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Group Accident, Sickness and Life Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 56, § 113, sub-§ II, ¶ A, sub-¶ 3, amended. Sub-paragraph 3 of paragraph A of subsection II of section 113 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 421 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'3. The policy must cover at least ~~25~~ 10 employees at date of issue.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 56, § 141-A, sub-§ I, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection I of section 141-A of chapter 56 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 316 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'C. The policy must cover at least ~~25~~ 10 employees at date of issue.'
