AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 6-A, sub-§ I, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection I of section 6-A of chapter 60 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 384 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘A. . . Any member in service may retire on a service retirement allowance upon written application to the board of trustees setting forth at what time, not less than 30 days nor more than 90 days subsequent to the filing thereof, he desires to be retired, provided that such member at the time so specified for his retirement shall have attained age 60, **except that teachers with 35 years of service within the state may retire with full benefits regardless of age**, and notwithstanding that during such period of notification he may have separated from service.’
