SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 93, L. D. 38, Bill "An Act Relating
to Signals for Stopping and Turning Motor
Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last 3 underlined lines
thereof and inserting in place thereof the following underlined
subsections:

' I. Left turn---hand and arm extended horizontally with
the index finger pointed to the left;

II. Right turn---hand and arm extended horizontally and
rotated from the rear to the front;

III. Stop or decrease speed---hand and arm extended
horizontally in a steady position with palm to the rear.'
