## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 95th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 95, L. D. 40, Bill "An Act Relating to Motor Vehicles Parking in Dangerous Places."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first paragraph thereof after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 19, §108, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 108 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to the driver of a vehicle which is disabled while on the paved, improved or main traveled portion of a highway or within 10 feet from the nearer cutside line of the traveled way of a public highway in such manner and to such extent that it is impossible to avoid stopping and temporarily leaving the vehicle in that position nor shall it apply to the driver of any vehicle while the same is employed in connection with the construction, maintenance or repair of pipes and wires of a public utility in, upon, along, over, across and under a highway."
