STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Speed of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 118, amended. Section 118 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'The state highway commission shall also have the authority to increase the speeds of either commercial or pleasure vehicles at any and all points on the highway where, in their opinion, a higher speed is warranted and they shall place all necessary signs to give notice thereof.'
