#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for John Smith, of Belgrade.

John Smith; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is granted to John Smith, of Belgrade, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pensions shall begin on July 1, 1951 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

John Smith is about 78 years of age. He is unable to qualify for old age assistance because of inability to prove citizenship. He has no money and is unable to work because of age and rheumatism.
