AN ACT Relating to Escapes from Jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 122, § 28, repealed and replaced. Section 28 of chapter 122 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 28. Escapes from jail; penalty. Whoever, being lawfully detained in any jail or other place of confinement, except the state prison, breaks or escapes therefrom, or attempts to do so, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than 7 years; the sentence to such imprisonment shall not be concurrent with any other sentence then being served or thereafter to be imposed upon such escapee.’
