## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Transporter Registration for Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 19, § 15, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection I of section 15 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered D, to read as follows:

'D. Any person engaged in a business requiring the limited operation of motor vehicles, tractors or trailers in order to facilitate the delivery, repair or improvement thereof, or the foreclosure or repossession thereof, or the installation of something thereon, or for the purpose of dismantling such motor vehicle, tractor or trailer may make application to the secretary of state upon a blank provided for that purpose for a certificate of registration to be known and designated as Transporter Registration. Upon payment of a fee of \$15 the secretary of state shall issue one set of transporter plates to each such applicant. If additional plates are required, they may be obtained by making application and payment of an additional registration fee of \$15 a pair.'
