IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert W. Traip Academy.

Robert W. Traip Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$50,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state to be expended by the president and the board of trustees of Robert W. Traip Academy toward the building and equipment of an addition to the present buildings for use in furnishing secondary school privileges to the youth of Kittery and vicinity.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Kittery's population has grown 50.5% in 10 years. Robert W. Traip Academy has never received any special aid from the state since its foundation. Federal aid cannot legally be considered in this matter.
