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**AN ACT Relating to Salary of Council in City of South Portland.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1933, c. 55, Art. 4, § 2, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of article 4 of chapter 55 of the private and special laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each member shall receive as salary the sum of ~~\$300~~ \$600 per year, payable quarterly, for all services rendered in his various capacities and shall not be eligible while a member of the council, to any other office of emolument or profit under the city charter or ordinances, nor to hold the office of city manager or to act as city manager, during the term for which he was elected.'
