## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 95th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 72, L. D. 78, Bill "An Act to

Clarify Certain Provisions of Motor Vehicle

Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out the next to last paragraph of section 20 of said Bill and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'All school busses when carrying children shall come to a full stop before crossing any railroad track or tracks, such stop to be made at a point not more than 50 feet and not less than 10 feet from the nearest rail; and the driver thereof shall take such steps as are necessary to ascertain beyond reasonable doubt that no train, engine or car is approaching the crossing before he shall proceed to drive such bus across the track or tracks. The operator of any school bus failing to so stop shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200; and his driver's license shall be suspended by the secretary of state for a period of not less than 2 years.'
