RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of New Sharon for School Building.

Town of New Sharon; appropriation for school building. Resolved: That the sum of \$15,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be expended by the town of New Sharon, Franklin county, for the purpose of completion and equipment of its school building and for furnishing facilities for pupils of secondary grades in said town of New Sharon.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fire has destroyed the school building in New Sharon, which building has been rebuilt to some extent by the town. The pupils are now being taught in the building, but it is vitally necessary that additional funds be made available to the town in order to complete the construction and to procure adequate equipment for conducting the school.
