COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 82, L. D. 107, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Incurable Insanity as a Cause
for which a Divorce may be Granted."

Amend said bill by inserting in Sec. 55, after the underlined words "United States", and before the underlined punctuation and word ", and" in the tenth line thereof the following words:
'for a period of five years'.

Further amend Sec. 55, of said bill by inserting after the underlined word "incurable" and before the underlined punctuation and word ",and" in the eleventh line, the words 'beyond a reasonable doubt'.
