HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 85, L. D. 109, Bill "An Act Relating
to Interlocking Interests in Liquor Licenses."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end thereof, before the

'Minor investment in securities of a corporation engaged in liquor
business not amounting to more than 10% shall not be held to be
an interest forbidden by the foregoing sentence.'
