SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 85, L. D. 109, Bill "An Act  
Relating to Interlocking Interests in  
Liquor Licenses."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end thereof, before the  
single quotation mark, the following underlined sentence:

' Minor investment in securities of a corporation engaged in  
liquor business not amounting to any substantial control  
shall not be held to be an interest forbidden by the fore-  
going sentence.'
