STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Interlocking Interests in Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 56, amended. The next to the last sentence of section 56 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'No Maine retail liquor licensee shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in any Maine manufacturer's or wholesaler's license or certificate of approval issued to an out of state manufacturer or foreign wholesaler of malt liquor; and no out of state manufacturer or foreign wholesaler having a state certificate of approval, nor any state wholesale or manufacturing licensee, shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in any state retail liquor license.'
