IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE,, Appropriating Moneys for Promotion of Highway Safety.

Promotion of highway safety; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$22,500 from the general highway fund and \$2,500 from the general fund for the promotion of highway safety; and be it further

Resolved: That such moneys shall be expended by the state police and shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to the increase in highway accidents and fatalities, it is necessary that highway safety and education be expanded.
