**AN ACT Relating to Retail Store Liquor License in Unincorporated
Places.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 23, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 23 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 245 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Retail store license applications for premises located in unincorporated places shall require the approval of the county commissioners of the county in which such premises are located.'
